### 6 UNESCO criteria apply to cities:

- 1. Masterpiece of human creative genius
- 2. Important interchange of human values
- 3. Exceptional testimony to a cultural tradition
- 4. Outstanding example of a type of building
- 5. Traditional human settlement
- 6. Events or living traditions










# Lijiang tourism arrivals increased from 1.5 million to over 25 million since listing
